

## **2023 CT Envirothon Oral Presentation Rules**

This year we are challenging teams to create a PowerPoint/Google Slides presentation based on the released current issue scenario to accompany their oral presentation. Teams will present their PowerPoint/Slides presentations in front of panel of judges at the Field Day competition at the Kellogg Education Center on Thursday, May 18th, 2023.

There is not a poster board component to these presentations.

All presentations should be submitted to <a href="mailto:ctenvirothon@gmail.com">ctenvirothon@gmail.com</a> no later than Monday, May 15th at 11:59PM, no exceptions. For Microsoft PowerPoint, please attach the file to an email, if your team's file size is too big please let us know and we can provide you with an alternative option. For Google Slides, please share the presentation with our gmail AND email us that you have shared it – a copy will be made of the shared presentation to ensure that teams will not edit it after submission. Teams should also bring their presentations on a flash drive on competition day as a backup if possible. Please see the rules below and the separate scenario document and scoring sheet for more details.

- 1. Presentation must be more than 9 minutes but less than 11 minutes.
- 2. The use of videos or sound on slides is prohibited.
- 3. Slides may use the animation features that are available with the PowerPoint and Google Slides software.
- 4. During oral presentations, all team members must wear the CT Envirothon shirt provided.
- 5. During oral presentations, no school or town identification, either written or verbal, is permitted. Please do not mention your school in your team introduction at all.
- 6. No props are allowed during the presentation.
- 7. Notecards are permitted during the presentation and should be handed in at the time of sign-in on competition day.
