Task requirements

Your presentation requires you to decide how to provide 100 homes for families. What types and placements will you have? They must have plans for one plug-in EV per household and figure out how to offset power requirements equal to 1000 Mwatts. Your solutions must use renewable energy sources, non-carbon fuels, or zero-carbon actions.

- Once your plan is identified, you will deliver it to the judges using a PowerPoint or Google slide presentation.
- The use of videos or sound on the slides is prohibited.
- Slide may use the animation features available with PowerPoint or Google Slides software.
- All presentations must be submitted to ctenvirothon@gmail.com no later than Monday, May 20th at 11:59 PM, with no exceptions.
- Also, bring your presentation to the event on a thumb drive.
- There are no props or visuals other than the PowerPoint presentation.
- The presentation must have at most ten slides, plus a title slide and a slide for your citations/references for 12 slides.
- Your presentation will be limited to a time frame of 9 minutes and 11 minutes at maximum.
- Judges will ask you questions following your presentation. You will be graded on your ability to answer questions. The period for questions will not extend past 4 minutes. The time of questions will not affect your score. Scoring is only based on your ability to answer the questions and the number of team members answering questions.
- Your team must not have any identifying marks or images of your school or town in your presentation, on your clothing, or visible in any way.
- All team members must wear the provided CT Envirothon shirt.
- All members of the presenting team must participate in the presentation.
- You will be able to use notecards during your presentation.
- Notecards will be left with the judges following your presentation.
